Winter 2011 : €5000 (Initiation)

Summer 2011 : € 5,400 (Initiation) ; € 5,800 (Advancing) ; € 6,100 (Perfecting)

Once your application into the French Pastry Arts program has been accepted, a down payment of 4000 Euros must be made in order to reserve your place.

The balance due must be made at least 30 days before the beginning of the program.

If the cancellation is made less than 45 days before the start of the program, no refund will be made.
